A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STONECREST DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD **NOVEMBER** 7, 2023 TO ON DETERMINE THE REIMPOSITION OR NON-REIMPOSITION OF A SPECIAL PURPOSE LOCAL OPTION SALES AND USE TAX AND FOR OTHER RELATED PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of DeKalb County (the "Board of Commissioners"), which is the governing authority of DeKalb County, Georgia (the "County") and which is charged with the duties of levying taxes, contracting debts, and managing the affairs of the County, and the DeKalb County Board of Registrations and Elections (the "Superintendent of Elections"), which is the Superintendent of Elections of DeKalb County, called an election that was held on November 7, 2023, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of DeKalb County the question of whether or not a special purpose local option sales and use tax should be reimposed; and

WHEREAS, the ballots used in the election provided that if reimposition of the tax is approved by the voters, such vote shall also constitute approval of the issuance of general obligation debt of the City of Stonecrest (the "City") in the principal amount of \$40,690,000 (the "General Obligation Debt"); and

WHEREAS, the returns of the election were duly brought up by the managers of such election, as required by law, and were presented to the City and the Superintendent of Elections for consolidation and for the declaration of the result of the election; and

WHEREAS, the returns of the election were received from all of the poll officers and thereupon the Superintendent of Elections canvassed, computed, and consolidated the returns of the election and concurrent with the adoption of this resolution delivered a certified copy of the consolidated return of the election to the City, and the result of the election in the City was as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Stonecrest, and it is hereby resolved by authority of the same, that the election resulted in favor of the reimposition of a special purpose local option sales and use tax, by an affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified voters of the City voting in the election held for such purpose, that

accordingly the issuance of the General Obligation Debt has been authorized as required by law, and that the results of the election are hereby declared to be as set forth above.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the authority aforesaid, and it is hereby resolved by authority of the same, that a duly certified copy of the consolidated election return of the Superintendent of Elections be attached to this resolution as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.
