ORDINANCE 2017-06-01

AN ORDINANCE TO SET AND ADOPT THE FISCAL YEAR FOR THE CITY OF
STONECREST GEORGIA AS JANUARY 1, 2017 THROUGH DECEMBER 31 2017
FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Stonecrest, Georgia is required by law to annually adopt a budget to guide and direct its receipt of revenues and its expenditure of funds;

WHEREAS, State law provides in Section 36-81-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated that the Mayor and Council must establish a fiscal year for the City;

WHEREAS, Section 5.01 of the City Charter requires the City Council to establish the fiscal year by ordinance. The fiscal year shall constitute the budget year and the year for financial accounting and reporting; and

WHEREAS, for financial and fiscal planning the City has studied options regarding the fiscal year and has determined the January 1st through December 31st time period provides the most conducive annual cycle; and


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF STONECREST THAT:

By passage of this ordinance, the Mayor and Council of the City of Stonecrest, Georgia adopts January 1st through December 31st as the City's fiscal year. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.


